"Using wireless technology, the solution transfers fingerprint data to a host device, such as a mobile data terminal," said Mike Oehler, VP of Product Management for Mobile Biometrics at Cross Match. "The biometric data can then be submitted to AFIS for fingerprint identification and the search results are displayed on the scanner."

Currently, the solution is in use by the Martin County Sheriff's Office, helping law enforcement officials prevent, investigate and solve crimes. "We have been using the system for a number of weeks now as part of our law enforcement program," said Robert Crowder, Martin County Sheriff. "
